

A Guided Tour

ASSIGNMENT SHEET 19 JAN. 2012

Part 1 Spend one hour exploring a place located within the District of Columbia, no more than a fifteen-minute walk of a Metro station. Consider what about your experience you would like to share with another student. Then, plan a tour, and devise a method for guiding two other students on your tour (separately, not at one time). Your method may use proper nouns (like street names) but may not use any other language.

DELIVERABLES. A way of sending two other students on your tour. You should not expect the students to go at the same time. You may not be present when the other student goes on the tour. Your method must cost less than \$20 to produce, and you may not use any network-connected media.

Part 2 **ASSIGNMENT.** Take two student's tours. For each tour, record your experiences and report back to the class. Focus on the usability of the tour instructions.

DELIVERABLES. For each tour, a 5–10 minute presentation, with a visual presentation.
